

Salina Sports Facilities

Salina, KS - This progressive community blends “big city” opportunities and “small city” feel to create a great place to live, work and especially play! Located in the center of the United States at the crossroads of Interstates 70 and 135, Salina is an ideal choice for sporting events!

Overall, Salina is currently home to more than 16 baseball and softball fields, 12 soccer fields, three 18-hole golf courses and two 9-hole golf courses, an outdoor aquatics center, three spray parks, three football facilities, two track and field sites, numerous tennis courts, fishing lake, playgrounds, skateboard area, roller skate center, bowling center, picnic areas and shelters, and more than 700 acres in the parks system. In 2009, Kansas Wesleyan University completed a 1500 seat gymnasium arena and activity center, and K-State at Salina opened a 32,000 square foot Student Life Center complete with gymnasium, indoor track.



Sporting events held in Salina include the NJCAA Women’s National Basketball Championship, Kansas Grand Slam Invitational Baseball Tournament, State High School Championships for Baseball, Basketball, Golf, Football, Softball, Tennis, Volleyball, and Wrestling; Salina Soccer Club Academies, ASA Youth Fast-Pitch and Adult Slow Pitch Tournaments, Triple Crown Sports Youth Baseball, Hap Dumont Youth Baseball, Sports Car Club of America races, gymnastics competitions, and more.

More than 25 lodging facilities provide nearly 2,000 room accommodations, and our diverse meeting facilities can seat from 10 to 7,000. Salina is home to excellent cuisine served by 80+ dining establishments. Unique attractions include a world-class zoo and wildlife museum, vineyard and winery, art galleries, historical museums, theatres, recreation and fun centers. Shopping opportunities are abundant at specialty shops, centers and an indoor mall.

A Preview of Salina Facilities

City of Salina, Parks and Recreation Department – 300 W. Ash – (785) 309-5765

Dean Evans Stadium is Salina's premier baseball facility, and features a covered stadium with seating for approximately 800, a digital scoreboard and adjacent practice fields.

Bill Burke Park is home to five soccer fields and 7 lighted baseball/softball fields with 250' fences. The park also features walking/biking trails, fishing and picnic areas.

Magnolia Soccer Complex – This Five-field Soccer Complex is home to the Salina Soccer Club, and is complete with excellent bathroom and concession facilities.

Golf

Salina has three 18-hole golf courses, and two 9-hole, par three courses. All of the courses are known for superb landscaping and challenging layouts.

Kansas Wesleyan University is home to Glenn L. Martin Football Stadium, Muir Gymnasium, MAYB Arena and new Student Activity Center. These facilities host NAIA events including football, basketball, volleyball, Heart of America Sports Camps and more.

Kansas State University at Salina – 2320 Centennial Road – (785) 826-2674

Although a college of technology, K-State University at Salina recently opened a 32,000 square-foot Student Life Center located adjacent to the Salina campus' College Center building. Amenities include: 1,400 capacity Basketball/Volleyball gymnasium, Racquetball/Handball court, cardiovascular and free weights area, aerobics/fitness area, second level running track (1/10 mile), lounge with 58" Plasma TV, billiards, ping-pong, and air hockey tables, and a computer station. The facility is open to K-State students, faculty, staff, alumni, and general public. All members of the public wishing to purchase a membership, must enroll in the K-State at Salina General Fitness Course which is 4 months, continuous enrollment. The cost of this course is \$100. Unified School District #305 – PO Box 797 – (785) 309-4712

The Salina School District can accommodate many high school sporting events. Latest enhancement includes the installation of turf to Salina Stadium. Other USD #305 facilities include gymnasiums, outdoor track & field, softball fields and more.

Salina Stadium – This 4,500 seat stadium is complete with newly installed turf, a 6-window press box, scoreboards, adjacent parking, locker facilities, and more. Great for football, soccer, band competitions and more!

Salina Family YMCA – 570 YMCA Drive – 825-2151

Most commonly the Salina Family YMCA is used by its members; however, sporting events are also frequently held at this facility. Indoors, the facility features two wood basketball courts, a tennis court, racquetball courts, indoor track, and swimming pool. Outdoors several youth soccer and football fields are available.
