MAC Position & Event Descriptions

All MAC activities must fulfill the mission of the council. All positions with the exception of volunteer, meet on the third Tuesday of each month from 11:30-12:30 p.m. at the designated location.

MAC Chair and Vice-Chair

The chair and vice-chair are responsible for coordinating and leading MAC meetings, and as necessary, subcommittee meetings. The vice-chair shall assist the chair, as requested by the chair. The vice-chair identifies potential MAC members to recruit for MAC vacancies. Both positions are expected to meet with subcommittees on a regular basis and support events and other activities approved by the MAC. **Term: 2 years**

MAC Secretary

The MAC secretary is responsible for creating the monthly agenda and writing monthly meeting minutes. **Term: 1 year**

MAC Member

The MAC Member position involves the member participating in MAC meetings, and as desired, on MAC subcommittees. Upon the conclusion of the term, the member may continue to participate as a volunteer. **Term: 2 years**

MAC Events Committee Chair

The MAC Events Committee Chair is responsible for coordinating and leading event meetings with event committee members and volunteers. The chair participates in the planning and execution of all events. Events include: Annual Armed Forces Day Golf Tournament, Wounded Veterans Poker Run, and other activities approved by the events committee/MAC. **Term: 2 years**

MAC Events Committee Member

The MAC Events Committee Member position involves the member attending event meetings and participating in the planning and execution of the events and activities they have elected to participate in. Events include: Annual Armed Forces Day Golf Tournament, Wounded Veterans Poker Run, and other activities approved by the events committee/MAC. **Term: 2 years**

MAC Commanders Club Chair

The MAC Commanders Club Chair is responsible for coordinating and leading Commanders Club meetings with Commanders Club Committee Members, and overseeing the Annual Commanders Club Dining Out and other Commanders Club activities approved by the Commanders Club Committee/MAC. The chair, along with Commanders Club Committee Members, identifies potential Commanders Club Members to recruit for the purpose of growing the membership base and increasing participation at events. **Term: 1 year**

MAC Commanders Club Committee Member

The MAC Commanders Club Committee Member position involves the member attending Commanders Club meetings and participating in the planning and execution of the Annual Commanders Club Dining Out, and other activities approved by the Commanders Club Committee/MAC. **Term: 1 year**

MAC Volunteer

The MAC Volunteer position involves the volunteer participating in activities and events they have elected to participate in. Events include: Annual Armed Forces Day Golf Tournament, Wounded Veterans Poker Run, Commanders Club Dining Out, and other activities approved by the MAC. Activities include: Labor retention. **Term: none**

Events

Annual Armed Forces Day Golf Tournament-held on Armed Forces Day in May, this event raises money for the Salina Military Emergency Relief Fund, which assists service members who reside within a 50 mile radius of Salina.

Annual Wounded Veterans Poker Run-held in June, this event raises money for the Gary Sinise Foundation, which provides assistance to wounded veterans and first-responders (firefighters, police and EMTs).

Annual Commanders Club Dining Out- held in the fall, this event brings together business, civic, retired and active military leaders at a formal event that includes a keynote speaker.
