Mass Gatherings	No more than 50 individuals in a mass gathering where 6-foot distance cannot be maintained; this does not limit the total occupancy allowed in a facility/event if 6-foot distance is maintained between individuals and/or family groups at all times	Maintain social distancing where applicable
Individuals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks are strongly encouraged in public settings where 6-foot distance is not maintained; • Maintain 6-foot distance in both indoor and outdoor settings; • High-risk individuals with underlying medical conditions should continue to stay home except for essential needs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain home if ill • Masks are strongly encouraged if ill and seeking medical treatment • Adhere to personal hygiene guidelines
Employers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow any sector specific guidance or mandates released by business licensors • May reduce telework and bring back employees to the office setting • Employees exhibiting illness should be required to stay home and encouraged to seek medical care as needed • Avoid gatherings greater than 50 where social distancing cannot be maintained and continue to maintain 6 feet of distance between workstations 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow any sector specific guidance or mandates released by business licensors • Employees exhibiting illness should be required to stay home and encouraged to seek medical care as needed
Travel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non-essential travel may resume • KDHE travel-related quarantine mandates are still in effect for high-risk areas 	Unrestricted
Educational Facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • K-12 and Higher education facilities should remain closed for in-person learning or events involving groups of more than 50 individuals when distancing cannot be maintained 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • K-12 and Higher education facilities should follow sector specific guidelines

Bars and Nightclubs	<p>Can open if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distance is maintained between all individuals and groups • Clean, sanitize and disinfect frequently touched surfaces regularly • Shared supplies and equipment should be disinfected 	<p>Unrestricted</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue enhanced cleaning and disinfecting
Large Entertainment Venues	<p>Can open if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distance is maintained between all individuals and groups • Follow cleaning protocols and public health practices, complying with sector specific guidance • Avoid groups larger than 50 where distance cannot be maintained 	<p>Unrestricted</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue enhanced cleaning and disinfecting
Fairs, Festivals, Carnivals, Parades	<p>Can open if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distance is maintained between all individuals and groups • Follow cleaning protocols and public health practices, complying with sector specific guidance • Avoid groups larger than 50 where distance cannot be maintained 	<p>Unrestricted</p>
Summer Camps	<p>Can occur if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distance is maintained between all individuals and groups; avoiding groups larger than 50 where distance cannot be maintained • Clean, sanitize and disinfect frequently touched surfaces throughout the day; maintain daily opening and closing sanitation schedules • Reinforce frequent/proper handwashing and hygiene; screen for symptoms upon arrival 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can operate at capacity • Clean, sanitize and disinfect regularly • Reinforce frequent/proper handwashing and hygiene • Shared supplies and equipment should be disinfected throughout the day • Staff should monitor children and other staff for symptoms of illness

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shared supplies and equipment should be disinfected throughout the day • Food and beverages should be served in individual portions and utensils shouldn't be shared 	
Swimming Pools	<p>Can open if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distance is maintained between all individuals and groups; avoiding groups larger than 50 where distance cannot be maintained • Clean, sanitize and disinfect equipment and frequently touched surfaces; enhance the cleaning schedule • Locker rooms/showers should be limited to 50% capacity with enhanced cleaning and sanitizing procedures and social distancing • Appropriate staff should wear PPE and wash their hand frequently; patrons are encouraged to wear PPE when it's safe/comfortable • Reinforce frequent/proper hygiene with signage; monitor staff for illness 	<p>No restrictions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Should display signage encouraging proper hygiene practices

Sports	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Groups greater than 50 should not occur when social distancing cannot be maintained • Spectators are required to practice social distancing; common seating like bleachers should not be used • Players should limit amount of time spent in close groups/huddles • Practices should have buffer time in between groups so overlap doesn't occur and equipment can be sanitized before reuse 	<p>No restriction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage social distancing when applicable • Signage should encourage distancing and proper hygiene • Shared equipment should be sanitized before reuse • Common seating like bleachers should be sanitized when possible

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start times should be staggered where no more than half of the facility is changing over at any given time • Benches normally used for the team should only be available if disinfected between use • Ball/equipment used should be disinfected between uses as possible • Signage should encourage distancing and proper hygiene • Concessions may open but should only offer separately packaged items • Players and spectators should not bring beverages to share 	
Meeting Rooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each room should not exceed mass gatherings of 50 if social distance cannot be maintained • Enhanced cleaning schedule; before and after use, during when applicable • Signage encouraging distancing and proper hygiene • Screen attendees prior to entering; encourage or require facemasks • Registered participants only; no walk-in availability 	No restrictions
Playgrounds	<p>Can open if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signage posted encouraging distancing, mass gathering restriction of 50 or less when distancing isn't maintained, and proper hygiene practices • Enhanced cleaning schedules when applicable 	No restrictions
Splash Pads	<p>Can open if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signage posted encouraging distancing, mass gathering restriction of 50 or less when distancing isn't maintained, and proper hygiene practices • Enhanced cleaning schedules when applicable 	No restrictions
Farmers Markets, Community Gardens	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not exceed mass gatherings of 50 when social distancing cannot be maintained • Clean and disinfect displays stands, tables and all equipment 	<p>No restrictions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signage encouraging proper hygiene should be posted

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide cleaning stations/hand sanitizer at each display • Disinfect shared equipment between use • Vendor booth should be at least 6 feet apart and ready to space customers if waiting in line (tape on floors, ropes, etc.) • Vendors and customers should wear facemasks • Only prepackaged items should be sampled with proper area to dispose of trash • Signage should encourage social distancing, proper hygiene and descriptions for rules 	
Garage/Estate Sales	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not exceed mass gatherings of 50 when social distancing cannot be maintained • Clean and disinfect displays, tables and equipment • Encourage facemasks 	No restrictions
Outdoor Restrooms	<p>Can open if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Restricted to one person/family at a time • Clean and sanitize frequently touched surfaces at regular intervals based on usage • Signage encouraging proper hygiene practices and social distancing • Prop doors open when possible and place trash cans near doors for easy disposal 	<p>No restrictions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signage encouraging proper hygiene practices should be posted
Gyms/Fitness Centers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not exceed mass gatherings of 50 when social distancing cannot be maintained • Group classes greater than 50 cannot occur • Clean and disinfect equipment after every use and frequently touched surfaces • Space equipment out by at least 6 feet • Locker rooms/showers should be limited to 50% capacity with enhanced cleaning and sanitizing procedures and social distancing • Screen staff/members before entering the facility 	<p>No restrictions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signage encouraging proper hygiene practices should be posted
