What service/product do you provide? Soggy Dog Suites. A unique beach-themed vacation destination for dogs, provides spacious lodging and daycare, as well as Canine Cove Self Wash. We feature a comfortable climate-controlled resort atmosphere with luxury lodging, including glass-front full view suites as well as private suites. Daycare is provided inside and out and features K9 grass, an antimicrobial grass-like surface for comfort, safety, and cleanliness. Soggy Dog is managed by trained pet care providers, seven days a week, 365 days a year, and monitored around the clock by video/audio security systems.

When did you start your business and why? Soggy Dog has a long history: we opened in 2005 as Soggy Dog Salon, a home-based family-owned grooming salon. In 2007, we expanded and moved downtown to Wood Fashion Plaza. When our clients expressed their wishes for lodging and daycare, we were able to expand again and, in 2014, moved to 640 N. Santa Fe, a 6,800 sq ft building, and changed our name to Soggy Dog Salon & Suites, Inc.



Anything else you would like the community to know?

We have created Canine Cove, a 2 station Self Wash, where anyone can come and wash their own dog! We provide everything needed (except the dog) at one low price. We have elevated tubs with ramp access, premium shampoo and conditioner, no coins, no time limit, best of all, no clean up!

What is something that no one knows about you?

In late 2020, to better represent our services, our business name was changed to Soggy Dog Suites, Inc.
