Gillam (Jack's son), Charles Renz, Maggie Gillam (Jack's granddaughter) and Chris Gillam (Jack's grandson). We're excited to celebrate 80 years of service in 2023 and we look forward to continuing to grow our business and our legacy within the community.

Anything else you would like the community to know?

We have recently gone through a brand update and a website revamp. Our new refreshed logo features our identifiable 'JGR' in a vibrant red color, with a unique focus on the 'G' creating a negative space within the center. The website features some new imagery of some of our favorite and most recognizable projects throughout Salina and the Central U.S. We are excited to launch the new marketing for the company and hope it will propel us forward as we continue to strive for success.

What is something that no one knows about you?

The team at JCR has designed over 30,000 projects, not just located in the state of Kansas, but all across the Central U.S. Our architects are licensed in 12 states (Kansas, Missouri, Iowa, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Texas, Colorado, Wyoming, Idaho, Utah, Arizona and California). Project sizes have ranged from small-scale remodels to upwards of 50 million dollars in new construction.
